

Report on the timetable for consideration of the Wild Animals and Circuses (Wales) Bill

July 2019

On 8 July 2019, a Government Bill, the Wild Animals and Circuses (Wales) Bill, was introduced in the Assembly.

On 25 June 2019 the Business Committee agreed, in accordance with Standing Order 26.9, to refer the Bill to the Climate Change, Environment and Rural Affairs Committee to consider and report on the general principles.

On 2 July 2019, the Business Committee agreed, in accordance with Standing Order 26.7, a timetable for the Committee's consideration of the general principles of the Bill and agreed that the Committee should report to the Assembly by 6 December 2019.

The Business Committee also agreed that Stage 2 proceedings should be completed by 14 February 2020, subject to the general principles of the Bill being agreed by the Assembly.
