

The Local Government (Best Value Performance Indicators) (Wales) Order 2005

This Order specifies performance indicators by reference to which the performance of county and county borough councils, in exercising their functions, will be measured from 1st April 2005.

Standing Order 11.7

No points have been identified for reporting under Standing order 11.7.

Observations

Schedule 2 sets out Housing Indicators. In NS6 the English text refers to those household found to be "statutory homeless"; the Welsh text refers to "ystatudol ddigartref". Legal translators have confirmed that the now accepted translation of "statutory" is "statudol" and not "ystatudol". Whilst not a reporting point, this should be taken into consideration in the drafting of instruments in the future.

The Performance Indicators specified in this Order apply with effect from 1st April 2005 to county councils and county borough councils. Members are referred to the Local Government (Best Value Performance Indicators) (Wales) (Revocation) Order 2005 (LC 1032 refers) which revoked the Local Government (Best Value Performance Indicators) (Wales) Order 2002 ("the 2002 Order"). The latter applied to county councils, county borough councils and National Park Authorities. As a result of the revocation of the 2002 Order combined with application of the subject Order, the performance of National Park Authorities in the exercise of their functions will no longer be measured against performance indicators.
