The Fly-tipping Action Wales (FtAW) programme, funded by the Welsh Government and operated by Natural Resources Wales, continues to support Monmouthshire County Council in tackling fly-tipping. This has included the recent provision of surveillance cameras and training. These cameras have already been deployed to target fly-tipping hotspots across the County. Other support has included action to tackle fly-tipping on the Gwent Levels through the very successful Living Levels “Black Spots to Bright Spots” project.
