NDM705 To propose that the National Assembly:

- **1.** Welcomes the provisions of the Assembly Local Government Bill which establishes a new ethical framework for local government.
- 2. Endorses the general principles and codes of conduct for members and employees of local

authorities.

- **3.** Supports the new investigatory functions proposed for the Commissioner for Local Administration in Wales and the establishment of an independent Adjudication Panel.
- **4.** Supports the requirement for local authorities to establish standards committees.

Add as new bullet point 4 and renumber remaining points accordingly: "Calls on the Commissioner for Local Administration in Wales (CLAW) to investigate the possibility of establishing an independent Audit Manager in each local authority."

Amendment 4 - William Graham (South Wales East)

Add a new point which reads:

"Regrets the lack of specification that Standard Committees should have a majority of nonelected members, together with a non-elected Committee Chair, and calls upon the Minister for Finance, Local Government and Communities to introduce this stipulation at the first opportunity."

Amendment 5 - William Graham (South Wales East)

Add a new point which reads:

"Regrets the power to grant dispensations to both elected and co-opted members rests with the Standards Committee, not with the full Council."

Amendment 6 - Jocelyn Davies (South Wales East);

Add as new bullet point at the end:

"Notes the importance of local councillors declaring membership of the freemasons."
