Alun Davies: Glaistir is not yet operational – it will become operational from 1 January 2012. The development for the implementation of Glastir has been carried out by the Department of Rural Affairs, supported by other Departments across the Welsh Government. It is not possible to provide the information requested as staff are not allocated to work wholly on Glastir; the work is additional to their day-to-day duties. As part of the external engagement process, staff from a variety of organisations, including Welsh Government Sponsored Bodies and farming and other countryside interests, have been involved in meetings and discussions on the Glastir scheme.

This represents detailed proposals that will now be subject to negotiation and agreement at the EU level. It will be some time before decisions are reached on the final shape of the CAP for implementation in 2014.
