Thank you for your recent written question, further to my response to WQ82838, asking me to provide a breakdown of the £800,000 of specialist palliative care funding, including how much of that funding was allocated to each hospice in Wales.

Please find below a breakdown of the £800k specialist paediatric palliative care monies as requested.
