



**Report on the Statutory Instrument Consent Memorandum for The Public Bodies (Abolition of Food from Britain) Order 2014**

Background

1. On the 9 May 2014, Alun Davies AM, Minister for Natural Resources and Food, in accordance with Standing Order 30A.2, laid before the Assembly a Statutory Instrument Consent Memorandum for The Public Bodies (Abolition of Food from Britain) Order 2014.

2. Standing Order 30A states that that a Statutory Instrument Consent Memorandum must be laid and a Statutory Instrument Consent Motion may be tabled before the Assembly if a UK Statutory Instrument makes provision in relation to Wales amending primary legislation within the legislative competence of the Assembly.

The Statutory Instrument Consent Memorandum

3. The memorandum states that:

“The objective of the Order is to abolish the council known as Food from Britain (FFB), established by section 1 of the Agricultural and Marketing Act 1983. This Order simply repeals the Agricultural Marketing Act 1983 and dissolves Food from Britain in law.”<sup>1</sup>
