Dear Hannah,

Thank you for your written question dated 30 July concerning the amount of capital that has been invested in each local authority for flood risk alleviation in each of the last five years. In my response, I made a commitment to provide a detailed answer to your question - please find attached the information requested:

During this Senedd term, the Welsh Government has made available over £300 million of capital and revenue funding in the annual Flood and Coastal Erosion Risk Management (FCERM) programme.

Capital funding for this purpose is provided by Welsh Government to Local Authorities and Natural Resources Wales – the table below provides a breakdown of both as allocated across each local authority area in Wales.

Please note that this table does not include the significant revenue commitment made via the Coastal Risk Management Programme (CRMP) which saw over £291m of concentrated investment over five years. Once completed, CRMP will have funded 15 schemes around Wales' coastline and benefitted almost 14,000 properties.
