Motions for Debate on 30 September 1999

Andrew Davies (Swansea West); To propose that the Assembly takes note of the action taken by the Administration in making the Orders listed on the subordinate legislation page of the intranet during the Summer recess. (NDM94VB)

Amendments

1. Jocelyn Davies (South Wales East); At the end of the motion on legislation moved in the recess add the following sentence

"The Assembly calls on the Administration to review the procedure for publishing information on subordinate legislation."

Andrew Davies (Swansea West); That the Assembly endorses the arrangements for consultation and Partnership with Business set out in the document named "Consultation with Business" tabled on Friday 24 September. (NDM95VB)

Amendments

1. Ieuan Wyn Jones (Ynys Mon); At the end of the motion on Partnership with Business add the following:

"That the First Secretary report to the National Assembly from time to time on the number and range of organisations representing business which are consulted in fulfilment of the requirements of Section 115 of the Government of Wales Act."

2. Michael German (South Wales East); add to the end " and further resolves that all parties in the Assembly be represented in the Business Partnership in proportion to their representation in the Assembly, and that a mechanism be put in place to enable representatives from all sectors in the Business Partnership to take items on the agendas of meetings."

3. Alun Cairns (South Wales West); In the "Consultation with Business" document, paragraph 11; before the words "representatives of Business Wales", insert "at least 4".

In the "Consultation with Business" document , Annex B, paragraph 2; replace the word "Member", with the word "Members".
