Annwyl Chris,

Mewn ymateb i'r ymgynghoriad sydd wedi'i hysbysebu ar <http://www.assemblywales.org/memhome/mem-paypensions/independentreviewpanel/irp-call-for-evidence-letter.htm>, mae gyda fi dau awgrymiad:

1: That reserved car parking spaces in the underground car park should only be made available to those Members who do not have a taxpayer-subsidised Cardiff area domicile. If the taxpayer is paying for a Member to have a domicile close enough to work to be practical for work purposes, then it should be close enough for the Member to walk, cycle or use public transport.

2: I understand that the Assembly is now collecting co2 emissions for all Members' business travel. Perhaps, in the spirit of openness and transparency, and in line with the commission's objective "we will work sustainability", it would be worth publishing the total emissions of each Member, and/or the emissions *per mile travelled* (which would provide a more appropriate measure given that the Members have such a geographical spread of both domicile and constituency).
