Thank you for your recent Written Questions asking me how the Welsh Government is raising awareness of symptoms associated with Type 2 diabetes in Wales.

The NHS in Wales provides information on symptoms of type 2 diabetes. These include:

- peeing more than usual, particularly at night.
- feeling thirsty all the time.
- feeling very tired.
- losing weight without trying to.
- itching around the penis or vagina, or repeatedly getting thrush.
- cuts or wounds taking longer to heal.
- blurred vision.

If people have concerns about any significant or prolonged changes in their physical health, then they should seek advice from their GP or NHS 111 Wales.
