I am responding to your written question WQ92330: How is the Welsh Government working with health boards to join-up data handling to ensure that patients do not have to repeatedly report their information to different healthcare professionals.

The Welsh Government is supporting the development of the National Data Resource (NDR). This is a major digital transformation programme, which will make it easier to join-up health and care data from various sources, within the health and care service in Wales. The programme is committed to adopting the principles of open architecture and adopting common data standards, which will make it easier for our IT systems to 'talk' to each other. When fully operational, it will enable healthcare professionals to access the relevant information about an individual and minimise the need for people to repeat details of their health information with different professionals.
