Linguistic and Democratic Rights in Euskadi

Recalling the cordial relations between the governments of Wales and Euskadi (the Basque country) for the promotion of bilingualism, the Assembly condemns the action of the Spanish government in closing down Egunkaria, the Basque-medium daily newspaper, and arresting ten members of its staff; and calls upon the Spanish government to reverse the prohibition of Egunkaria, and to respect human linguistic and democratic rights in Euskadi and in all parts of Spain.

Regulation of Pharmacy Contracts

The National Assembly for Wales is concerned that the recommendations of the recent Office of Fair Trading Report into the regulation of pharmacy contracts will undermine the highly valued network of community pharmacies in Wales because they:

- pay no regard to the provision of high quality patient care by local community pharmacies;
- undermine the patient centred services at the heart of the Assembly's Pharmacy Strategy;
- will lead to the closure of local community pharmacies especially in rural and disadvantaged areas;
- will lead to the exclusion of less well off and less mobile patients from local pharmacy services.
