Cross-Party Group Monitoring Report

November 2024

Introduction

- This paper is prepared by the Table Office for the Standards of Conduct Committee ('the Committee) in accordance with paragraph 44 of The Rules on the Operation of Cross-Party Groups ('the rules'). It provides an overview of the activities of the Senedd's Cross-Party Groups ('CPGs') between 6 October 2023 and 6 October 2024. The report will inform the Committee's consideration of actions it may wish to take, or recommend that the Llywydd take, concerning CPGs that have not complied with the rules during the reporting period.
- 2. Under paragraph 41 of the rules, failure to comply with, or contravention of the rules could ultimately lead to withdrawal of recognition of the CPG on the authority of the Llywydd (the CPG would be de-registered and marked as such on the Senedd website).

Registered Cross-Party Groups

3. A total of 81 CPGs have been registered since the beginning of the Sixth Senedd, with three new CPGs being registered during the current reporting period¹. Three CPGs (Long-COVID; Eating Disorders; and Digital Rights and Democracy) have been wound up voluntarily over the last year.

¹ The GPG on Gypsies and Travellers was registered on 9 October, after the reporting period for this year, and so are not included in this report



Compliance

- **4.** The rules on the operation of CPGs require CPG Chairs to provide the following information to the Table Office within specified timescales:
 - As much advance notice of meetings as possible (including meeting dates, times and venue);
 - Notification of the election of office-holders (within four weeks of the election taking place);
 - Submission of minutes (within four weeks of the meeting taking place);
 - Notification of any changes to the details of the CPG (within four weeks of the changes coming into effect);
 - The holding of an Annual General Meeting every twelve months, after which the Chair must provide an Annual Report and Financial Statement within six weeks of that meeting taking place.
- **5.** A summary of each CPG's activities and compliance with the rules is outlined in **Annex A**. Compliance with the rules has been categorised as follows:
 - Green: CPGs who have provided all the necessary information within the required timescales.
 - Yellow: CPGs who have provided one set of minutes late or not at all.
 - Orange: CPGs who have provided more than one set of minutes late or not at all, and/or not provided an Annual Report and Financial Statement.
 - Red: CPGs who either appear to be inactive or who have not complied with the rules at all, and which are brought to the Committee's attention.
- **6.** A list of the CPGs, along with the names of Chairs and persons/organisations providing secretarial support, is included in **Annex B**. Full details of all CPG meetings are available on the **Senedd's website**.

7. Annex C shows all registered CPGs and, using the same categories set out in paragraph 5, shows their compliance record over the three reporting periods since the start of the Sixth Senedd.
