I am writing in response to your written question - Will the Minister set out what was discussed with representatives from Anglesey and Gwynedd councils at their meeting on 5 December? (WQ86926)

I did not meet with representatives from Anglesey and Gwynedd councils on 5 December. My only recent meeting with them was when I visited Menai Bridge on 30 November.

During that visit we discussed the Menai suspension bridge – the decision to close the bridge, current mitigation measures in place, free parking proposals, bus measures and active travel initiatives along with the next steps. I also held a brief discussion with Gwynedd regarding Llanbedr and our willingness to work with the Council to introduce sustainable transport measures in the area.
