All expenses claimed for by Members of the Senedd (MSs) are published on the **Allowance Publication System** including all travel expenses.

In order to find this information on our **allowances system**, please follow these instructions:

1. Select the financial years and/or months you wish to search.
2. To select a specific Member of the Senedd, select 'MEMBER PICKER' and view the list of previous and current Members and select Lee Waters.
3. To select the specific expense type, select the 'ALLOWANCE TYPE PICKER' and select the following:
  - a. 'Mileage'
  - b. 'International Travel'
  - c. 'UK Travel'
  - d. 'Family Travel'
  - e. 'Additional Costs Allowance'.
4. Select 'Search'
