Dear

I am writing as a follow up to your Oral Assembly Question of 9 March in relation to the Environment (Wales) Act.

To date I have not had any direct discussions with the National Grid with regard to the biodiversity and resilience of ecosystems duty set out at section 6 of the Act. However, my officials will be meeting the National Grid to discuss the new biodiversity duty in the near future.

National Grid did respond to the Welsh Government's Environment Bill White Paper consultation in 2013, in which it indicated support for our proposals. Following Royal Assent of the Act on 21 March, I will be writing to all public authorities who will under a duty to comply with the section 6 duty. This includes the National Grid.

I would like to take this opportunity to highlight that I anticipate that statutory guidance on the section 6 duty will be issued to public authorities later this year to ensure that they are aware of their statutory requirements and our expectations on compliance with the duty. There is existing guidance on the current biodiversity duty contained in section 40 of the Natural Environment and Rural Communities Act 2006, which public authorities will be aware of.

I should reiterate that responsibility for electricity grid infrastructure consenting lies with the UK Government and is planned and delivered by National Grid.
