- 1. Albion Water Limited;*
- 2. Cases before the Competition Appeal Tribunal relating to water supplies to Shotton Paper;*
- 3. Legal action between Dŵr Cymru and Corus relating to water supplies to its plants at Llanwern, Trostre and Shotton*
