Dear Huw,

I am writing to you following your exchange with the Minister for Finance and Trefnydd during business questions on 24 September regarding the potential for eCargo schemes.

There are no eCargo schemes in Wales. However, officials will be looking at the potential of how ebikes and similar transport modes can benefit active travel as part of the Wales Transport Strategy. We are currently refreshing the Strategy and will be publishing by the end of 2020. It will set out our policies for Transport and build on existing commitments for an integrated transport system that supports sustainable forms of travel.

With regards to the Department for Transport eCargo Bike Grant Fund scheme, it is only open to organisations, not individuals. It is also only available for organisations who will implement the measures in England. A Scottish or Welsh organisation can apply if they can demonstrate the ecargo bikes will be used exclusively in England.
