Dear Heledd,

Following my oral statement celebrating late immersion provision in Wales, and the subsequent discussion, I committed to sending you a list containing the different models of late immersion operated by local authorities across Wales. I hope the attachment to this letter addresses that.

As I mentioned in my statement, each local authority is at a different stage in their late immersion journey and the variations in how late immersion is provided in different areas reflects that. I don't see this as a weakness. It's important that local authorities and practitioners have opportunities to reflect which model or combination of models meets the need within their areas. I'm aware, for example, that Rhondda Cynon Taf Council supported 18 learners through their late immersion provision during the last academic year, with 7 already transitioned into Welsh-medium schools. What I think is interesting is the desire among local authorities and late immersion practitioners to learn from each other. That's not limited to just areas at the beginning of their late immersion journeys. The most experienced local authorities such as Gwynedd, Ceredigion and Carmarthenshire are also benefiting from the experiences of the south-east, particularly in supporting learners identified as those that would benefit from having an additional linguistic boost. I see this collaboration and colearning here as a strength.

We have supported Estyn over the past year to pilot local authority late immersion inspection arrangements. This is the first time this has happened and I'm looking forward to seeing what we can learn from that pilot. I want to see local authority late immersion provisions across Wales grow and evolve to provide a pathway for more children, of all abilities and backgrounds to acquire the Welsh language.
