Thank you for your written question. Our latest audit return, from January 2024, has identified that there are currently 8 individuals from Wales with a diagnosed learning disability receiving care in a mental health unit in England.

It is important to recognise that these individuals will have a primary mental health diagnosis but will also have a co-occurring learning disability and are not detained primarily due to their learning disability.
