I am writing in response to WQ97660, in which you asked "What action is the Welsh Government taking to support Holocaust Memorial Day events?"

Holocaust Memorial Day is one of the annual events of national importance marked and supported by the Welsh Government. Each year, we work in close partnership with the Holocaust Memorial Day Trust and Cardiff Council to deliver the national Holocaust Memorial Day event in Wales.

In addition to the national event, the Welsh Government supports the "Light the Darkness" national moment on the evening of 27 January by lighting its buildings in purple, symbolising solidarity and remembrance.

In September 2025, I agreed to provide three-year grant funding to the Holocaust Memorial Day Trust to support the continued delivery of Holocaust commemorations in Wales.
