LEGISLATION COMMITTEE REPORT

The Education (Extension of Careers Education) (Wales) Regulations 2001

Background

These Regulations extend the requirement for careers education to pupils in schools who are over the compulsory school leaving age and students attending institutions within the further education sector.

They are to be considered in Plenary under the standard procedure.

General Observations

Regulation 2

As Regulation 2 is introducing wording which is notionally substituted for section 43(5), it is accepted that the gender specific references occur from a desire to keep as a close as possible to the wording of section 43(5).

The drafting of Regulation 2 accords with advice given by Parliamentary Counsel in consequence of the drafting lawyer referring this matter to Parliamentary Counsel by reason of its effect on primary legislation. Section 44 is referred to because of the reference to section 43 in section 44 (10) (a) (i).
