During Questions to the Minister for Finance and Public Services on 18 June 2008, which I took in the absence of Andrew Davies AM, I agreed to write to you on your question relating to the financial provision made to deliver the *One Wales* commitment on family nurses and to provide you with an update on progress.

One Wales gives the commitment to providing 'a minimum of one family nurse per secondary school by the end of the Assembly term'.

Work has been ongoing throughout the year, initially with children and young people to seek their views on this development. This was followed by stakeholder conferences across Wales to help inform a consultation document which will be issued in the Summer.

A budget of £4.5m has been allocated over three years to support this commitment. It is not possible to provide how the detail of the monies will be used until a model of providing a family focussed service has been agreed.
