Thank you for the written question you tabled for my response on 13 January 2025.

(WQ95367): Will the Cabinet Secretary give an update on the progress of the work towards establishing a national school of government?

Following exploratory work as part of the Co-operation Agreement as to how a National School of Government might contribute to a step change in embedding the idea behind a One Wales Public Service, resources have been concentrated and directed to deliver greatest impact.

Achievements to date include:

- Delivered and published a Landscape Map – detailing in one place the public service organisations offering learning programmes for Welsh public service and third sector staff.
- Developed a first Curated Offer – providing Leadership interventions to target public service leaders and organisations, depending on where they are in their leadership journey.
- Fast-tracking the design and development of innovative leadership support programmes, commissioning new programmes addressing gaps identified through research and analysis.
