Dear Angela,

I am writing in response to WQ82105: Will the Minister detail the number of elective hip and knee replacements that have taken place in each health board broken down by month for the last 24 months?

The need to focus on the pandemic response, to ensure people with coronavirus receive life-saving treatment, has inevitably had a significant impact on planned procedures, such as elective hip and knee replacements. Planned procedures were postponed at the start of the pandemic to ensure the NHS was able to respond to the pandemic.

During the second wave health boards have tried to balance restoring elective activity where local circumstances allow, whilst also responding to winter and pandemic pressures.

Just like all other parts of society, the NHS has had to introduce measures to protect people from the risk of contracting coronavirus and these measures have also had an impact on the amount of planned activity the NHS can provide – for example, a reduced number of outpatient appointments are being provided because of the need to introduce enhanced cleaning arrangements between appointments.

It has not been possible to see and treat the same numbers of patients as before the pandemic due to the physical changes and safety arrangements in place to ensure patients and staff are protected, and these protective measures will need to continue for some time.

Within health boards, staff who work on coding the information contained in the medical notes were also been deployed to other roles. This will impact on the quality and completeness of data for 2020.

Please see below, data for the number of elective hip and knee replacements by local health board and month for the calendar year 2019 and 2020 provided by NHS Wales Informatics Service (NWIS) on 11 February 2021.

The principal procedure is defined as the operation/operative procedure relating to the principal condition for which the patient was treated or investigated. Excluding patient class 3 and 4 (Regular Day/night admission).
