Dear Adam

You recently requested, by a written question, an updated timeline for the construction of the Llandeilo bypass.

We are currently considering the range of views expressed by the public and stakeholders with regards to Llandeilo at WeITAG Stage 2 in order to present proposals that could secure consensus amongst key stakeholders and allow the work to progress to WeITAG Stage 3.

To facilitate this consensus my officials will arrange a meeting with Carmarthenshire Council officers to discuss proposals to progress to Stage 3. Should agreement be reached between both organisations, medium-term measures could progress this Autumn and be delivered within 3 years. The development of long-term measures would progress in parallel.
