

The Governor Allowances (Wales) Regulations 2005

These Regulations provide for the payment of allowances to governors and non-governor members of committees of governing bodies by the governing bodies of maintained schools which have a delegated budget. The Regulations also provide for allowances to be paid by local education authorities to governors of maintained schools not having a delegated budget, to non-governor members of committees of maintained schools not having a delegated budget and to persons appointed to represent the local education authority at further and higher education institutions or on the governing body of an independent school or a special school not maintained by the local education authority. The Regulations revoke the Education (Governors' Allowances) Regulations 1999 in relation to Wales.

Standing Order 11.7

Observations

The Regulations come into force on 31st October 2005 which is the same as one of the enabling powers cited i.e. section 19 (3) of the Education Act 2002. This provision is brought into force by the Education Act 2002 (Commencement No 7) (Wales) Order 2005. The other enabling powers cited are already in force.
