To ask the Minister for Rural Affairs

Peter Rogers (North Wales); What representations has the Minister made to DEFRA concerning the 20 day rule governing livestock movements. (WAQ15979)

Peter Rogers (North Wales); Has the Minister's department prepared a new or updated contingency plan to deal with an animal disease outbreak in Wales. (WAQ15980)

Peter Rogers (North Wales); What has the Minister done to review and improve meat import controls. (WAQ15978)

Peter Rogers (North Wales); What is the Minister's policy on any further transfer of powers from DEFRA to the Assembly. (WAQ15981)
