Request for Information.

Thank you for your request received 28 September in which you asked:

How many LGBTI Catholics in contact or working for the Welsh Assembly including LGBTI Catholic MWP's have reported being persecuted, detained, imprisoned, institutionalised, harassed, abused, bullied, fired, targeted, politically persecuted or otherwise oppressed by any person of the Welsh Assembly or by any other person or organisation instigating the Assembly to do such between 1/1/2014 - 25/9/2015:

For:

A) Disagreeing, protesting, intimating, publishing, professing, or preaching that homosexual marriage or civil partnerships are immorally wrong, intrinsically disordered, unnatural, illicit, evil or contrary to the will of God.

B) Disagreeing, protesting, intimating, publishing, professing or preaching that homosexual sex is immorally wrong, intrinsically disordered, unnatural, illicit, evil or otherwise contrary to the will of God.

We hold no recorded information relating to your request.
