Detrimental Effect of Licensing Bill on Music

The National Assembly for Wales expresses concern that the Licensing Bill proposals will have a detrimental effect on musicians and live music performances in Wales, particularly in smaller venues. The National Assembly urges the UK Government to remove the inequities faced by musicians and the music industry as a whole including;

- The replacement of the anomalous two in a bar rule with a none in a bar rule.*
- Penalties of a six-month jail sentence or a £20,000 fine for breaking the law.*
- The requirement for the provision of entertainment facilities to become licensable which will ensnare shops, studios and teachers.*
