Dear Mark,

I'm writing following your exchanges last month during questions to the Trefnydd on the Business Statement, where you raised the provision of covered tennis courts in Wales.

The Welsh Government provides funding for sport through Sport Wales. In 2025-26 we have provided £10m of capital funding, which is an increase of £2m from 2023-24. This funding supports National Governing Bodies, sports organisations and clubs through various grants. Part of this funding is allocated to a Court Collaboration project, a partnership between Sport Wales, Tennis Wales, Basketball Wales, and Wales Netball. Since the project's launch in 2022-23, Sport Wales has made 17 awards for the improvement of courts for those sports, totalling over £1.4 million.
