Er nad oes ystadegau sy'n ymwneud ag amlder yr afiechyd sbectrwm awtistig yng Nghymru, mae'r Cynulliad yn nodi fod ymchwil tramor yn dangos cynnydd brawychus yn yr achosion o awtisiaeth. Amcandybir fod 27,300 o bobl â'r afiechyd sbectrwm awtistig yng Nghymru, ond nid oes darlun cywir o'r angen ar gyfer cynllunio darpariaeth briodol. Erfyniwn ar y llywodraeth i gomisiynu astudiaeth epidemiologol gyflawn i glustnodi'r nifer a monitro'r tueddiadau; ac i hwyluso'r broses o glustnodi a dehongli'r afiechyd yn gynnar a chael polisiau cynhwysol effeithiol yn y system addysg ac yn y gymdeithas yn gyffredinol ar gyfer pobl sydd â'r afiechyd sbectrwm awtistig.

This Assembly notes that, though there are no prevalence statistics for autistic spectrum disorders in Wales, overseas research indicates an alarming increase in the prevalence of autism. 'Best guess' estimates suggest that there are 27,300 people with an autistic spectrum disorder in Wales, but no accurate picture of need from which to plan appropriate provision. We therefore urge the government to commission a full-scale epidemiological study to establish rates and monitor trends; and to facilitate early identification and diagnosis, and effective inclusive policies in both educational settings and society in general for people with autistic spectrum disorders.

That the National Assembly for Wales exercises its power to make a commencement order bringing into force Part IIA of the Environmental Protection Act 1990 which contains measures that would require remediation of contaminated land which blights Wales. It would provide a coherent strategy for identifying, assessing and remediating historically contaminated land such as the former Phurnacite land in Cynon Valley and assigning liabilities on the basis of the "polluter pays" principle. The Assembly has a duty to ensure that this commencement order is enacted as a priority, to enable the release of land for industrial development, housing and leisure.

The National Assembly welcomes the UK Government's commitment under the OSPAR convention to work towards substantial reductions in radioactive discharges to the sea by this year, and close to zero concentrations in the marine environment by 2020. The National Assembly notes that reprocessing of spent nuclear fuel is the major source of radioactive pollution on the welsh coastline; believes that such pollution is unacceptable, and therefore applauds the resolutions submitted by Denmark and Ireland to the next OSPAR meeting, calling for immediate suspension or cessation of reprocessing.

Yn croesawu menter Ynni'r Dyfodol yr Ymddiriedolaeth Arbed Ynni, y cynllun achredu swyddogol cyntaf i hybu ynni o ffynonellau adnewyddadwy; yn nodi y caiff defnyddwyr o dan y cynllun yr hyder i ddewis opsiwn amgylcheddol ar gyfer eu cyflenwad trydan a fydd yn esgor ar gynhyrchu llai o garbon deuocsid; yn credu y gallai'r cynllun wneud cyfraniad sylweddol at darged y DTI bod 10% o'n trydan yn dod o ffynonellau adnewyddadwy erbyn 2010 ac yn croesawu ymrwymiad diwedd y Canghellor i eithrio trydan a gynhyrchir o ffynonellau ynni adnewyddadwy newydd ac mewn pwerdai 'gwres ac ynni' cyfun 'o ansawdd da' rhag talu'r Ardoll Newid Hinsoddol.

Welcomes the Energy Saving Trust's Future Energy Initiative, the first official accreditation scheme to promote energy from renewable sources; notes that under the scheme consumers will now be able to choose with confidence an environmental option for their electricity supply which will result in reduced emissions of carbon dioxide; believes that the scheme could make a considerable contribution towards the DTI's target of 10% electricity from renewable sources by 2010 and welcomes the Chancellor's recent commitment to exempt from the Climate Change Levy electricity generated from 'new' renewable sources of energy and in 'good quality' combined heat and power plant.

Mae'r Cynulliad hwn yn nodi y byddai'r Mesur Cartrefi Cynnes ac Arbed Ynni (Rhaglen 15 Mlynedd) a gyflwynwyd yn sesiwn 1998/99 y Senedd yn golygu 15 mlynedd o weithredu i sicrhau bod mesurau arbed ynni yn cael eu cymryd mewn cartrefi nad oes modd eu cadw'n

gynnes am gost resymol; bod gweithredu o'r fath yn cyfrannu at drechu tlodi mewn tanwydd, ei fod o les i'r amgylchedd ac yn creu swyddi; yn nodi bod gwireddu'r amcan hwn yn dibynnau ar berswad a gwaith hyrwyddo ac yn galw ar Lywodraeth y DU i gael hyd i'r amser i ailgyflwyno'r Mesur yn y sesiwn hon.

This Assembly notes that the Warm Homes and Energy Conservation (15 Year Programme) Bill introduced in the 1998/99 session of Parliament would require a 15 year programme of action to ensure that energy conservation measures are taken on homes which cannot be kept warm at reasonable cost; that such action will contribute to tackling fuel poverty, benefit the environment and create jobs; notes that it relies on persuasion and promotion to achieve its goals and calls on the UK Government to find time to re-introduce this Bill in the current session.
