
Procedure for dealing with complaints against Members of the Senedd – flow chart



If the Committee finds a breach of the Code it will then consider whether sanctions should be recommended for the MS

The **Committee will prepare report of its decision** to which will be attached the Commissioner's report and any other relevant information (the Committee can remove personal information if it considers it necessary)

The Committee may also draw attention to any matters of general interest arising from the complaint.

If the Committee finds a breach:

The Committee publishes its report and sends copies to the complainant and the MS being complained about.

A motion is tabled for the Committee's report to be **debated by the full Senedd**.

The Senedd then decides on whether to impose the recommended sanction.

If no breach is found:

The Committee publishes its report and sends copies to the complainant and the MS complained about.
