Dear Andrew,

I wish to correct an inadvertent error I made in answering a question from you during questions to party spokespeople on Wednesday 27 March 2019 and in answer to WAQ78070.

The transcript is copied below with the statement underlined.

“We are currently undertaking a great deal of work in this area. I don't accept that they're just a cut-and-paste. You'll be aware of the detailed work I've done particularly with the farming unions and other stakeholders to come forward with a voluntary approach. I was very keen to have a voluntary approach in the first instance. **Unfortunately, last year, we saw about a 200 per cent increase in agricultural pollution incidents,** which I think is unacceptable.”

Rather than a 200% increase, I was actually referring to the fact last year we saw an increase in agricultural pollution incidents to a figure of nearly 200.
