I am writing to response to coronavirus-related Written Questions, which you submitted and have not yet received an answer. Please accept my apologies for the time it has taken to respond to these questions.

WQ81412: Will the Minister provide a detailed breakdown of all expenditure associated with the Dragon's Heart hospital at the Principality Stadium, including the recent decommissioning costs?

The most recent estimate of costs for the Dragon's Heart Hospital (as of 15<sup>th</sup> March) is £58.5m – broken down as £55.7m revenue and £2.8m capital. Officials are working on finalising these with Cardiff & Vale University Health Board.
