The Welsh Assembly Government employs a total of 27 (FTE) press officers. In addition to communicating the policies of the Assembly Government through an increasingly dynamic and fragmented media, the press office provides media support to the government on a 24 hour, 7-days a week basis and also manages the online news service.

Andrew RT Davies (South Wales Central): How many members of staff are employed by the Welsh Assembly Government with responsibility for media monitoring, giving figures for each of the last four years. (WAQ56871)

The Welsh Assembly Government does not specifically employ staff to monitor the media. Press Officers carry out a monitoring role as part of their routine work alongside a range of other duties.

Andrew RT Davies (South Wales Central): How much does the Welsh Assembly Government spend annually on media monitoring, providing figures for each of the last four years. (WAQ56872)

The table below provides information on media monitoring costs that the central Communications division is aware of for the last four financial years. The service enables us to record and collate media coverage for all Government areas including health, tourism and education.

Central Communications division has a contract for media monitoring services which covers the majority of work in this area. We can supply the figures over the period requested (as outlined above). However, in addition to the central communications contract there may be other media monitoring work carried out for specific campaigns, within individual departments. To attempt to capture any additional expenditure would incur disproportionate costs. The Welsh Assembly Government has introduced a new financial

system which will enable us in future to have this information to hand. In addition to this, we will be publishing expenditure such as this on our website on a quarterly basis.

The figures are not easily comparable year on year as they may vary depending upon the departmental budgets that were delegated to Communications division within each financial year. The difference in cost is also due to the fact that we pay for cuttings on an individual basis, and is dependent on the amount of media coverage.

The increase in 2009-10 was due to the provision of broadcast monitoring services being provided by an external supplier. This service has now been brought in-house for 2010-11 with a resultant saving.
