I am responding to your written Senedd question on what impact assessment did the Welsh Government undertake on the likely impact on communities in west Wales of the decision not to renew funding for Fflecsi Bwcabus

Despite promises that Wales would not be a penny worse off after Brexit, the UK Government has failed to replace funding for rural transport schemes previously supported by EU – including the Bwcabus service.

The Welsh Government has not undertaken any specific impact assessment of Bwcabus as this is a local authority managed service.
