## Dear Adam

I promised to write with a substantive reply to the question you recently tabled:
What assessment has the Minister made of staff to student ratios in each Welsh university and what are the trends since 2018, by university? (WQ89688)

Caution should be exercised in examining this data at an institutional level because staffstudent ratios will vary for many legitimate reasons, including the nature and subject mix of provision. For example, ratios may be impacted by distance learning/online provision or franchised provision, where a student is enrolled at an HEI but the staff work for an FEI partner. It should be noted that student: staff ratios are only one aspect which contributes to the quality of the student experience and should not be considered in isolation. HEFCW has in place a quality assessment framework to ensure that the quality of higher education provision in Wales meets the reasonable needs of learners. This takes into account a range of data and information, as well as regular cyclical external peer review, to provide assurance on quality.
