Thank you for your email request received 18 March in which you made the following request for information;

.....please could you forward your policy about filming requests for government owned property....

The Assembly Commission's responsibility is only for the Assembly estate, which includes the Senedd. In relation to the Assembly estate, the core policy throughout the Third and Fourth Assemblies has been that no media operation, including filming, should interfere with the proper conduct of Assembly business. Your request, and your subsequent email, relate more broadly to policy for government owned property being used as filming locations. We do not hold any information relevant to that general request; you would need to approach the Welsh Government or relevant Whitehall Department to ascertain whether there are such policies for government owned property.
