To propose that the National Assembly:

1. Acting under section 1(1) of the Inquiries Act 2005 causes a public inquiry to be held under that Act into the recent E-coli outbreak;
2. Instructs the Minister for Assembly Business to table a motion under Standing Order 8.1 within two weeks to establish a Committee, to whom shall be delegated all functions contained in or under the Inquiries Act 2005 in respect of the Inquiry referred to in paragraph 1;
3. Acting under section 62(1)(a) of the Government of Wales Act 1998, resolves to delegate all functions referred to in paragraph 2 to the Committee referred to in that paragraph on the day it is established, save those which by law cannot be so delegated.
4. Instructs the Minister for Assembly Business to table a motion under Standing Order 8.4 within two weeks to elect the Committee referred to in paragraph 2, the Committee to consist of five Members, two from the Labour Party, one from Plaid Cymru The Party of

Wales, one from the Welsh Conservative Party, and one from the Welsh Liberal Democrat Party.
