The Committee considered *Guidance in Respect of Countryside and Rights of Way Act 2000 (Commencement No.9 and Saving) (Wales) Order 2006 (rights of way and meeting the needs of those with mobility problems),* which came under Standing Order 29, at its meeting on 1 March 2007.

Members requested reassurance that the Guidance had been scrutinised by the Committee on Equality of Opportunity and raised concerns regarding accessibility of areas with rough terrain.
