Darren Millar (Clwyd West): By local authority, what was the total number of complaints received in each of the past 5 years and what were the reasons for the complaints? (WAQ53407)

Darren Millar (Clwyd West): By local authority and in each of the past 5 years, what was the total number of recorded injury accidents on pavements? (WAQ53409)

Darren Millar (Clwyd West): By local authority and in each of the past 5 years, how many local authority employees were dismissed and what were the reasons for dismissal? (WAQ53410)

The Minister for Social Justice and Local Government (Brian Gibbons): The Welsh Assembly Government does not collect this information centrally.

Darren Millar (Clwyd West): By local authority and in each of the past 5 years, what was the total number of accidents involving local authority employees at work? (WAQ53408)

Brian Gibbons: The Welsh Assembly Government does not collect this information centrally. However the Health and Safety Executive do produce statistics on work-related accidents and may be able to provide information on accidents involving local authority employees at work.
