Dear Adam,

I am writing to respond to a coronavirus-related Written Question, to which you have not yet received an answer. Please accept my apologies for the time it has taken to respond to this question.

WQ81285: Will the Welsh Government provide figures for the proportion of care staff and residents that have been tested for COVID-19 over the last four weeks as of 14 October 2020?

Within the four-week period from week commencing 21 September 2020 to week commencing 12 October 2020, NHS Wales laboratories carried out 29,181 tests for COVID-19 for care homes, of which 11,490 were for residents. There were 59,379 tests done in non-NHS Wales laboratories, which cannot be split by resident or key worker.
