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Dear Natasha,

I am writing further to your recent written question regarding the feasibility of reopening the railway line from Carmarthen to Aberystwyth.

The Aberystwyth to Carmarthen Feasibility Study published in 2018 estimated the cost of reinstatement of the line at £775m, and reinstating the line as a heavy rail route would be challenging both in terms of cost and route given subsequent development.

As rail infrastructure is not devolved, a new heavy rail link would need investment from the UK Government, while we ensure that the our own investment in the infrastructure for which we are responsible maximises the impacts on modal shift and climate change. We must look at strategic options to improve connectivity that are affordable as choices will need to be made regarding what investments will have the greatest impact in tackling climate change.
