The Minister for Children, Education, Lifelong Learning and Skills (Jane Hutt): We are not aware of any Higher Education Institutions (HEI) that does not accept the Welsh Baccalaureate Qualification as a valid entry qualification.

There are some 307 HEIs in the UK, of these 159 (52%) make specific reference to the Welsh Baccalaureate Qualification in their entry requirements. 77% of the HEIs use the UCAS Tariff in framing entry requirements.

Within HEIs different courses do, of course, have their own distinct entry requirements. Of approximately 49,000 HE courses, over 23,000 make specific reference to the Welsh Baccalaureate Qualification in their entry requirements and over 30,000 use the UCAS Tariff. This means that, even where there is no specific reference to the Welsh Baccalaureate Qualification in entry requirements, its Tariff points can be counted.

The high level of recognition of the Welsh Baccalaureate Qualification as an entry qualification is very encouraging. However, we continue to work with partners, including UCAS and the Higher Education Advisory Team (HEAT), lead by the University of Bath to further analyse data and to promote the Welsh Baccalaureate Qualification within HEIs.
