POLICY REVIEW OF PUBLIC TRANSPORT

I thank you for the opportunity to consider the contents and recommendations contained within the Environment, Planning & Transport Committee's 'Policy Review of Public Transport' consultation report.

This Authority has worked closely with the WLGA in formulating a response on behalf of all unitary Authorities in Wales, and as a member of the TAITH consortia in preparing a regional response. The TAITH response endorses the WLGA submission, supplemented by examples of joint working between Authorities within the TAITH area. The Association of Transport Co-ordination Officers will also be endorsing the WLGA response, a submission that ATCO Officers throughout Wales, have been actively involved in its compilation.
