- 2. Please ensure ALL Senedd and/or Welsh Government run X accounts are included with your amounts.
- 3. Do you have to pay extra for the same ads in both the Welsh and English languages?

On 8 February, you confirmed that your request should cover the period since May 2021, the start of the Sixth Senedd.
