The Minister for Economy, Science and Transport (Edwina Hart): We have provided over £7million to support businesses within Enterprise Zones. These funds have levered a further private sector investment of over £19 million, which will support over 2000 jobs. In addition over £4m has been committed in Business Rate support within Enterprise Zones. We have not directly supported any businesses to relocate into an Enterprise Zone from another part of Wales. My officials continue to monitor this to ensure that economic activity isn't being displaced.
