The Equality Act is very clear, assistance dog owners have the right to go into these places. The Equality and Human Rights Commission is the body in Wales responsible for implementation and adherence to the provisions within the Equality Act 2010 and works with Welsh Government to highlight areas where Welsh Government is able to intervene from a policy perspective.

We are currently engaging with the Retail Forum on developing a Retail Delivery plan and I have asked my officials to ensure that this matter is considered as part of their discussions.
